Please fill out the form below to reserve space for the Charlotte Coin Club's 49th Annual Coin Show. Make your check payable to the Charlotte Coin Club and return the completed form to: Charlotte Coin Club P.O. Box 33292 Charlotte, NC 28233. The show will be held at the new/old location, The Park Expo on February 8, 9 and 10. A minimum, nonrefundable deposit of \$25.00 is payable with this application. Refunds for bourse fees will not be given for cancellations made after February 1st but can be applied to the next show. The bourse fee schedule is as follows:

\$215.00 per 8' table, paid in full after January 1, 2019

Early registration discount: Paid in full or postmarked by December 31, 2018 - \$200.00 per 8' table. The bourse fee per table includes: one (1) 8 foot covered display table with backup table, chairs, electrical hookup, and two dealer badges. 4' add-ons are back by popular demand. Display cases can be rented for \$15.00 for the three-day show, maximum of six per contract. The number of cases is limited so please reserve early. We also have a limited number of lamps to rent for \$8 each. Dealer set-up will be from 5 PM to 9 PM Thursday February 7th (no one before 4 please) and any time on Friday or Saturday. All persons working behind dealer tables or present on the bourse during non-public hours must wear a badge. Walk-around or Early Bird badges for non-tabled dealers are \$50; for entry during all dealer hours. Dealers may sub-lease space only with the permission of the Bourse Chairman. Any Dealer selling counterfeit or altered coins (unless so marked) will immediately forfeit his space without refund. Please remember that this is a three-day show and attended by some big spenders on Sunday. We are asking for your estimated time of departure on Sunday, or you can specify Saturday, as it may be possible to fill vacated spaces with local, Sunday-only dealers. Security will be furnished at the show by off-duty Charlotte police officers (plus Club members during loading and unloading). However, dealers are WARNED that the presence of security personnel does not constitute a guarantee against loss. As of July 1, 2017, North Carolina no longer requires the collection of tax on coin and bullion transactions. NO SMOKING: NC Law forbids Smoking during public hours.
