General Bourse Information and Rules

- Standard Tables Include: Use of one 8' table, four chairs, one backup table, and one electrical outlet. Please note that some tables may have shared backup space due to location or space limitations.
- Standard Allstate Showcases and lamps are not provided unless requested on the Bourse Application at the listed rental rates. Availability of additional showcases and lamps at the show will be limited.
- Night table covers will be provided on request.
- Booth space may be shared, but we request a maximum of two share dealers per table. For safety and security, a maximum of three badges will be allowed per booth space without prior approval of the Bourse Chairman. Only persons listed on the application will be permitted behind the bourse table.
- Refund of fees in the event of Dealer cancellation will be at the discretion of the Bourse Chairman if received in writing prior to 11/1/2025.
- Dealers offering altered, counterfeit, or other spurious material, or who conduct themselves in a manner deemed detrimental or who violate any provisions of this agreement will be subject to expulsion from the show, without recourse.
- Security officers will be on the bourse floor for the entire show.
- Dealers will be admitted to the bourse floor at 6pm on Friday (Dealer Setup and Early Bird only), 8 am on Saturday and 9am on Sunday.
- Public show hours: Saturday 10am to 6pm.; Sunday 10am to 4pm.
- No disruptive signs or lights of any kind will be permitted.
- CONVENTION SIGN LIMITATIONS: Hanging signs behind dealer tables are limited to approximately 18"x 24", table signs on backup table 18"x 24", table signs on front tables 8.5"x 11". Dealers with multiple booths are allowed one hanging sign (at approved dimensions) per booth rented. No hanging banners will be allowed. Table covers with dealer name/logo that hang to the ground in front of the table are fine. We need to keep a level playing field for all dealers in the room. Please limit signs (if possible) to advertising your business/business location/type of coins sold. Signs such as "Official Buying Table" or "Official Appraisal Table" will not be allowed as they tend to confuse the buying public.
- Applications and all fees are due by October 1, 2025.
- Any disputes on the bourse floor will be settled by the convention General Chairman or Bourse Chairman.
- BY SIGNING THE BOURSE APPLICATION, THE APPLICANT DEALER AGREES TO HEREBY RELEASE THE WILLAMETTE COIN CLUB, the Holiday Inn Portland Columbia Riverfront, THE CITY OF PORTLAND, ALL PARTICIPATING OR SPONSOR CLUBS, AND THE OFFICERS, MEMBERS, COMMITTEES, AGENTS AND EMPLOYEES OF EACH, IN THEIR OFFICIAL AND/OR INDIVIDUAL, PERSONAL CAPACITIES FROM ANY LIABILITY FOR LOSS, DAMAGE OR DESTRUCTION (THROUGH NEGLIGENCE, GROSS NEGLIGENCE, OR OTHERWISE) OF NUMISMATIC MATERIAL AND FOR PERSONAL INJURY AND PROPERTY DAMAGE OF ANY KIND.
