You're invited to attend the 32nd Annual Manhattan Coin Club show on **Saturday, February 7th, 2026**, at **Pottorf Hall, Cico Park, 1710 Avery Ave, Manhattan, Kansas** (NOTE: new location). Last year's show was well attended, with dealers giving positive feedback. This year's coin show will be advertised locally and nationally. The date of this year's show was changed to avoid scheduling conflicts and attract more traffic. We've also found a nicer space for our show and hope it will serve us for years to come!

Rental for 8-foot tables will be \$50 each if reserved two weeks before the show, January 24th, and \$60 after that, assuming we haven't run out. Each table rented will include one back table. A \$20 deposit per table can reserve your table. Balances due must be paid in CASH on the day of the show. Failure to show may result in rental fee forfeiture. Table assignments depend upon when payments are received and dealers' preferences. We will cancel the show and issue refunds in the event of inclement weather.

Dealer setup opens at 7 AM the day of the show. Dealers may enter the Hall's west side entrances to unload. You may unload at a door and then park in the small west side parking lot. Customer parking and the general entrance will be on the east side. Tables will be marked with renters' names. You must provide tablecloths. You can bring lamps and extension cords (remember, you might be far from a plugin, though this facility does have more than our previous one).

Pizza, snacks, drinks, and coffee will be available for sale. You can bring your food and drink. Quite a few fast-food restaurants are located less than a mile away.

To keep table prices low, we ask our dealers to donate an item for our raffle, allowing us to recoup our advertising costs through this optional gift. We are looking for something valued at around \$25 to \$30.

General public access will be from 9 AM to 4 PM that day, with no "early birds." Only dealers with paid-for tables, dealer assistants, or people involved in conducting the show may enter before 9 AM. While non-uniformed security and cameras will be on hand, dealers may also take personal security measures. Complete and mail the table reservation form on the back of this page.
